### GAIN INVESTMENT CHALLENGE

The Investment Challenge is a fantastic opportunity for female and non-binary students to learn more about the investment industry whilst gaining valuable experience and developing their skills.

Each team of 3-5 students will be allocated a company to research and over 8 weeks will develop a stock pitch advising on whether to sell, buy or hold on the company.

Each week students will be guided through the steps of developing a stock pitch in sessions delivered by industry experts. All teams will also be allocated a investment mentor, who will provide personalised guidance and support throughout the competition.

At the end of the challenge students will submit a 3-5 minute stock pitch video and a supporting research document, that will be reviewed and judged by our expert panel.

#### PRIZES:

The winning team will receive £1000 for their school and £200 in vouchers for each individual team member. Runners up will receive £500 for their school and £100 in vouchers per team member.

Both teams will be invited to the GAIN Awards event in the summer to collect their prizes!

The Talent Foundry aims to increase social mobility by helping young people from underserved backgrounds discover what they are amazing at, develop valuable new employment skills and take that first step into the world of work.

We run bespoke programmes with partners across private, public and not-for-profit industries. All our programmes help young people to develop confidence and self-belief, but also include a more explicit focus on skills development. This can include core transferable skills such as teamwork, problem solving, public speaking, self-confidence, resilience and creativity as defined in the Skills Builder Framework.

### YOUTH VOICE CENSUS REPORT

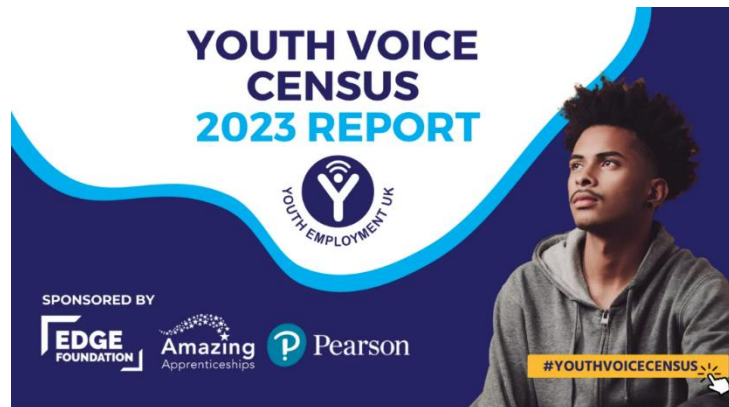
[Youth Voice Census 2023 - Youth Employment UK](#)

Pressures including the pandemic, educational disruption and last year's mental health crisis have left young people opting out, with a growing sense of 'them and us'.

The Youth Voice Census is an annual temperature check on how young people in the UK feel about life, study, work and general prospects. Over 4,000 young people aged 11-30 took part in 2023. It is the largest survey of young people in the UK.

This year's [Youth Voice Census findings](#) indicate that young people are feeling disconnected from where they live with increasing concerns of what their futures might hold.

The 2023 Youth Voice Census was spearheaded by Youth Employment UK with support from Amazing Apprenticeships, Edge Foundation, and Pearson.

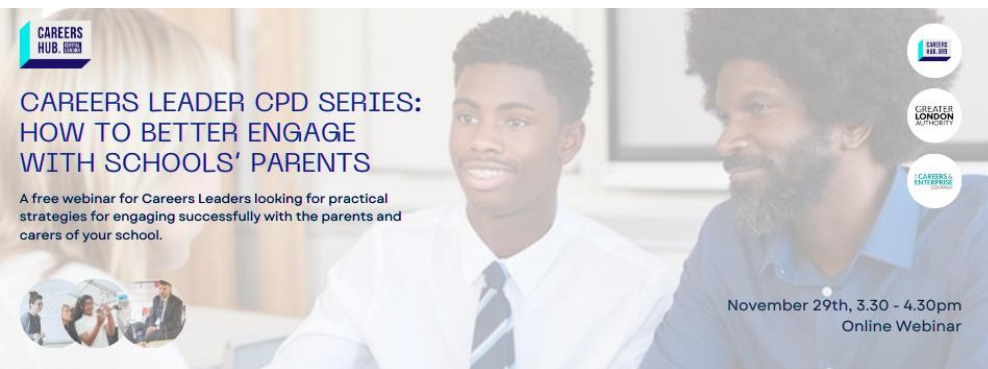
